Stop the Beeping

Due to the amount of different alarm systems, the following instructions may not apply to your alarm panel. If this is the case and the beeping has not stopped after trying the instructions below, you will need to speak to an emergency on call service technician.

- DSC and/or Partner Model Press *2#
- Honeywell Model Press your four-digit code then the number 1
- Honeywell Touch Screen Model Press the disarm icon then your four-digit code
- Westec Model Hold the lower left-hand corner * button for three seconds

STOP THE KEYPAD BEEPING:

Your System has been manufactured to initiate beeping from the keypads when "trouble" has been detected ie: loss of power with a low battery, broken sensor, etc.

To stop the beeping, push on the keypad.

STOP THE SYSTEM FROM GOING "CRAZY":

If your system initiates the alarm siren it can be silenced by disarming as usual. If that doesn't work, most likely due to a lightning strike of power surge, you need to disconnect the transformer from the wall receptacle and disconnect the two (red and black) wires attached to the battery in the master panel.
